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
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CORE VALUES

- **We provide the right climate to learn effectively.** Behaviour is exemplary. Students understand the importance of core values and the mutual benefits gained by everyone in a community where we all demonstrate respect, politeness, tolerance, resourcefulness and resilience.
- Sixth Formers, as our student leaders, take responsibility for their own appearance within a smart standard. **An industrious work ethic is engendered, leading to greater success.**

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

- The school has the highest expectations for all students, **adding significant value to the progress made by students** and achieving excellent academic standards in each key stage.
- The school is proud of its broad curriculum offer where our values, or “Golden Threads”, run through from Year 7 to Year 13. **We sustain choice for students**, with 4 options still available at GCSE, and a broad range of A level and post-16 courses for our students to progress onto.
- We have an impressive track record of working with all our young people to get them through to their desired next career step, whether that be university, apprenticeship or directly into employment. **Nearly all achieve and sustain their desired career destination.**



PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

- **The school runs an extended working day on a Thursday to provide high quality personal development opportunities for all students.**
- Each student chooses one activity per term from a wide range of options, from climbing, archaeology and aerobics to debating, gardening, conversational languages and charitable work. The Duke of Edinburgh Award is available at all levels from Year 10.
- Students either work together across year groups or choose an activity that is age-related, for example, taking a subject beyond A Level as excellent preparation for university. **This provision advantages all our students with a greatly enhanced personal portfolio** or CV to sit alongside their academic results.



FACILITIES

- **September 2021 will see the opening of a new Humanities block with 4 classrooms, adding to the new PE/Dance classroom that we opened in 2020.** This builds upon the recent refurbishment of our Technology suite and complements the provision of high quality facilities across the curriculum, with 8 specialist Science laboratories, Drama and Art studios and the best sports facilities in the district.
- The Sixth Form Common Room includes a designated servery and refreshments area with vending machines, a social area, and a study room. In addition, Sixth Form students will be gaining an extra learning resource centre in the East Wing from September 2021.
- Every student has an iPad to enhance the quality and variety of the learning experience. Staff are highly skilled in using the iPads within their teaching. Our remote learning provision was excellent from day one of the lockdown and our **iPad scheme will continue to deliver important learning advantages for our students in the years ahead.**



TRANSPORT

- **Malton School offers a range of additional contracted bus routes itself at a heavily subsidised rate**, with charges being tiered according to distance from school. Services operating in 2021/22 can be seen on our web-site but include routes along the A64 to Filey; along the A170 from Kirkbymoorside and Pickering; and covering Sheriff Hutton and Southern Ryedale.
