Food: Packed lunch and a bottle of water. *If your child is entitled to free school meals, your child will be provided with a school pack lunch. As a year 2 they also qualify for a universal free school meal. Therefore, we ask you contact the school office if you **DO NOT** require a school packed lunch.*

Voluntary Contributions:

For any trips requiring transport or entrance costs, you will be approached to make a voluntary donation through ParentPay, our safe and secure payment system, by doing so you are also consenting that your child can attend the trip. If you are unable to make a donation you will be required to give written consent via the school office.

All of our excursions will be planned in advance; however, if we do not receive enough voluntary payments to cover the costs, then unfortunately it will not take place. In these circumstances all payments already paid by parents will be refunded back to the Parentpay basket.
